



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is GeoTrax Survey™ Non-Invasive?

1. How deep do you go into the subsurface?

We look down 10 to 100's of feet on our sites, but our stakes only go into the ground about a foot. The technique is indirect. The flow of current generates the image, not the electrode.



2. What happens if the location is covered with pavement?

An 1/2-inch diameter hole is drilled through the pavement and metal stakes are driven into the soil about a foot. The holes in the pavement are patched upon completion of Aestus' work on-site based on client specifications.



3. Is it safe to be around GeoTrax Survey™?

Our surveys use less than one amp of current for less than a second for each measurement. Because this is such low current, it is considered safe to travel past our survey lines. Pets and livestock are kept clear of the area to protect the equipment, not the animals.
