



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

STAKE HOLE PATCHING

After the electrodes are removed from the site, do you fill and patch any holes in asphalt or concrete surfaces?

YES

- Stake holes are cleaned and free of any loose debris
- Holes are filled with caulk patch material (asphalt or concrete colored)
- Patches are smoothed and level with the surface of the concrete or asphalt



Temporal Monitoring via GeoTrax Survey LTM™

- Temporal monitoring requires the installation of multiple dedicated electrode rods
- Dedicated electrodes cannot be moved between imaging events
- Plastic or metal caps are placed over top of electrode locations to protect them from foot and vehicle traffic
- At the conclusion of a project, electrode caps can be left in place or removed and the hole filled with asphalt cold patch or concrete patching material as appropriate
